Who can Participate:

This workshop is offered to Collaboratives that have progressed to Phases 3 and/or 4 of More Resilient Minnesota. If interested, Collaboratives will need to send at least 2 representatives from their Teams to this workshop. Collaboratives can send more than 2 people.
