### **FAMILYWISE PROGRAMS**

Our programs help families build resiliency, identify and harness their strengths, and connect to other resources. We provide a continuum of services and a circle of care that wraps around families to keep them safe and healthy.



# FAMILY SUPPORT PROGRAMS

### **High-Fidelity Wraparound**

This program uses the evidence-based elements of family voice and choice and "wrapping" supports around families. We help families tap into a network of informal "natural supports."

### **Supervised Parenting**

In cases of family separation or family violence, we offer supervised parenting visits between non-custodial parents and their children in a safe environment.

### First Step Child Care

We offer parents a highly accredited early childhood program, the First Step Early Childhood Development Center, in the Prospect Park neighborhood of Minneapolis.

# COMMUNITY EDUCATION PROGRAMS

### **Tribal NEAR**

Builds the knowledge, skills, and confidence of tribal community members around neurobiology, epigenetics, ACEs and resilience (NEAR) research and holistic health topics to strengthen the self-efficacy of tribal communities in creating healing systems.

### **NEAR Communities**

This initiative shares the latest science on trauma and resilience to support individual and community-driven efforts to foster understanding, hope, and healing. We train people so they are empowered to raise awareness about the effects of trauma and the promise of prevention and resilience in their communities.

### Parent Leadership

Provides training to parents with expertise navigating family service systems so that they can share the wisdom of their experience with policy makers, family-serving agencies and organizations, and other families in the community.

# PARENT EDUCATION & SUPPORT PROGRAMS

### **Parent Education**

Support for families at risk of experiencing abuse or neglect.

This is a voluntary home-based program where family specialists work with parents to strengthen their parenting and life skills to avoid future systems involvement.

### **Bright Beginnings**

A voluntary program for young parents ages 12-24 who have a history of out-of-home placement or justice system involvement. Thee adolescents receive life skills training, parent education, and mentoring.

### **Circle of Parents**

The program offers peer-led support groups where parents can share challenges, successes and build their resilience. We host over 50 support groups for statewide parents and children across the state where they find new supportive connections.
